## Update: Llay, Wales

We have had a blessed two months with Easter and several outreach activities at the church in Llay. Things have been a bit more hectic as we fill in for the Quades while they are in the States for a short furlough. God has been so good to us as we labor here and has opened doors recently.

As I stood there with the headteacher of **Darland High School** watching 750 young people and 50 staff file into their gymnasium and take a seat on the floor he leaned over and said "it must be unusual to see so many young people dressed in school uniforms" (see photo) – hinting at the less

formal dress standards in America. Looking over the sea of green I answered "No, what is unusual is being invited to speak to an entire high school about God and the Bible!" A few weeks prior, I mailed Headteacher Agnew a short letter of introduction and offered to come and speak at his school. In his phone call back he enthusiastically agreed (less load on his staff to bring a talk). At the last minute he expanded the assembly to the entire school instead of 2 grades originally planned because of recent school snow cancellations. According to Mr. Agnew, he is required to hold regular assemblies

which are to include a short message on faith – that day's topic: **TRUTH**. I used two key Bible verses - John 8:32 and 14:6 – to proclaim truth from God's perspective. In my short 8 minutes I was able to share the truth of Jesus Christ, the consequences for sin and the way of salvation (only not able to do an altar call). So far, the response from the headteacher, staff and students has been positive – Mr. Agnew is an atheist but sees the need for this instruction (amen) - please pray that they invite me back soon and that this door remains open. This was clearly one of our most amazing experiences in the past year and a half! Try doing that at your local high school!
